To underline the importance, which the company dedicates to EMS and OHS, systems according to ČSN ISO 14001 and ČSN ISO 45001 were implemented and relevant certification was achieved.

Top management of SUNGWOO HITECH s.r.o., in the interests of EMS and OHS management and in the line with its strategic objectives and goals, announces this EMS and OHS policy, which commits itself to:

- Ensure continuous monitoring and evaluation of its environmental aspects,
- Continuous reducing of emission of greenhouse gases through implementation of technological innovations and processes, enabling carbon neutrality to be achieved by year 2050,
- Provide products to its customers in a way that considers environmental issues and long-term sustainability,
- Use energy consciously and, where possible, reduce energy consumption and thus CO2 emissions measured in tons per production unit as well as continuously increasing the share of energy from renewable sources,
- Strive to maximize the sustainability measures at workplaces by reducing the waste production, waste recycling and reusing,
- Operate in accordance with appropriate permits while ensuring minimal impact on the quality of the air and underground and surface waters,
- Handle chemicals responsibly and in accordance with valid legislative and principles of environmental protection,

- Allocate resources for the implementation and enforcement of objectives in accordance with the EMS and OHS policy,
